Djim, head nurse in the operating theater at **Ngaoubela Protestant Hospital**, Cameroon, specializes in anesthesia and intensive care. He loves his job, earning recognition for his accomplishments and participating in continuing education opportunities, including a training seminar for palliative care and pastoral counseling of patients. He is deeply engaged in his work, and with his patients. In September, 2022, a four-day old baby was brought to Ngaoubela, not eating, fever, constant crying, blunted reflexes. The baby was diagnosed with bacterial meningitis and Mr. Djim took responsibility for monitoring the tiny patient. When the baby stopped breathing, Djim initiated cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), performing multiple interventions. The baby survived and today is seven months old.

Healing happens every day in GHM's partner health centers - and many days, lives are saved - because dedicated nurses like Djim bring their skills and compassion to work.
