A nurse at **Ngaoubela Protestant Hospital**, Cameroon, Mairama tended to a young motherof three children from Yoko who came to the hospital and tested positive for tuberculosis. Several days after being admitted to Ngaoubela, the young woman suffered a tragic loss – the death of her husband, followed immediately by the death of her youngest child, only 8 months old. She fell into a deep depression. Mairama and her colleagues at Ngaoubela brought her all of their support – physical, psychological, emotional, everything they could think to do for her. After all of their efforts she overcame the blow and left the hospital healed and stronger than before.
